If you are not already aware of our poster specifications, please read the following information carefully so that you prepare your poster correctly and understand your obligations during the Meet the Future session.

Poster setup

It is preferred that you put your poster up on **Monday**, but **no later than** the first coffee break on Wednesday morning. The boards will be available on Monday in **Sequoia** on the Atrium level at the Hyatt Regency. Follow signs on the Atrium level to Sequoia. Ask at the conference registration desk for details when you arrive on site.

- You will be allotted 4-foot x 4-foot (~1 m x 1 m) of space on which to place your poster materials.
- A sign attached to each board indicates where your presentation should be posted. Find the board that has the sign containing the FINAL ID assigned to your work in the program.
- Push pins are provided.
- The display area is not secured; please do not leave valuables unattended.

*Conference attendees will be at the Interactive Paper (Poster) Session on Wednesday, 29 January 2020, 5:00 pm – 7:00 pm, to discuss **your** Interactive Paper presentation with you.*

Interactive Paper Session

- You are expected to stand by your poster the **entire** time of the Wednesday, 29 January 2020, 5:30 pm – 7:00 pm session to discuss your work with the attendees.
- Authors who are present to discuss their posters with attendees will be credited to qualify for proceedings publication.
- Light refreshments will be provided during the session.
- Authors may remove poster materials at the conclusion of the Interactive Session, or by the end of the morning coffee break on Thursday at the latest. Posters not removed are considered unwanted and will be removed by staff and discarded. IS&T does not assume responsibility for posters left up before or after the Interactive Session.
- Please note that conference registration badges are required for entrance.
